John pastored Keystone Church—Assemblies of God until June 2006 when he handed it over to Filipino control (it was a primarily Filipino congregation). This freed John to concentrate on the AIBI. Eternity Christian Fellowship is a house church that John & Minda have started, they also want to establish house churches wherever there is a
